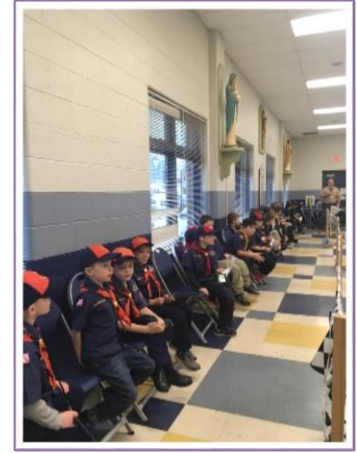
March Pack Meeting

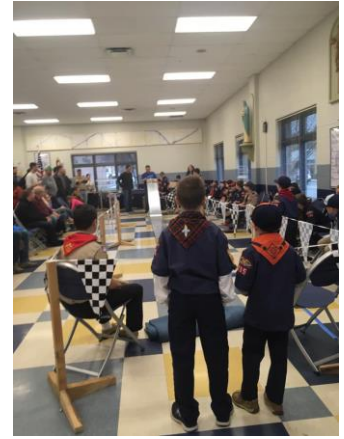

Winter Camp – What to bring...

- ✓ Sleeping bag (and possibly an extra blanket)
 - ✓ Pillow
 - ✓ Pajamas
 - ✓ Toothbrush
 - ✓ Toothpaste
 - ✓ Rain coat/gear
 - ✓ Winter coat
 - ✓ Winter hat (2)
 - ✓ Gloves
 - ✓ Boots/shoes (at least 2 pairs including at least 1 that can get muddy)
 - ✓ T-shirts (4)
 - ✓ Pants (4)
 - ✓ Sweatshirts (2)
 - ✓ Socks (5 pairs)
 - ✓ Flashlight/headlamp
 - ✓ Soap
 - ✓ Wash cloth
 - ✓ Bath Towel
 - ✓ Slippers/Skyzone socks to wear within the cabin (highly recommended so we do not track snow/wetness everywhere!)
 - ✓ Money for the trading post

- If the weather looks snowy, please also bring snow gear (long underwear, snow pants, etc.) Sleds for sharing are also welcome and strongly encouraged.
 - Please no electronic devices for Scouts.
