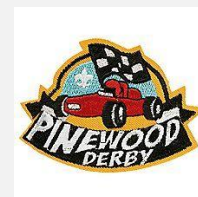

Winter Camp

Winter camp will be held the weekend of February 21-23 at Camp Tuckahoe in Dillsburg. We will be staying at the medieval castle. Check out <https://newbirthoffreedom.org/camping-2/camp-tuckahoe/tourct/medievalcastle/> for the amenities!

The capacity for Winter Camp is 40 people (20 Scouts and a parent). Each scout must have an adult stay with him. All scouts, no matter the rank, are eligible to stay overnight. The fee is \$15 per person, to cover the cost of the cabin rental and food. **All interested scouts must sign up and submit payment by the Pinewood Derby. If you are interested, register and pay early as it is a popular event!**

Not ready to stay overnight yet? That is fine! Just come for the day on Saturday, February 22! Enjoy camp activities, meals, and a campfire! Cost for the day is also \$15, as it covers the cost of meals and supplies for activities. Sign-up and payment must be received by the Pinewood Derby. First to sign-up with payment are the first to stay over!

Summer Camp

It seems strange to talk about summer camp following winter camp, but it will be here before we know it! The Scout Council has given a deadline of February 1 for a deposit for summer camp participants.

If you are interested in summer camp, a deposit of \$50 for Cub Camp (this year's Tigers and Wolves) is required. A deposit of \$60
