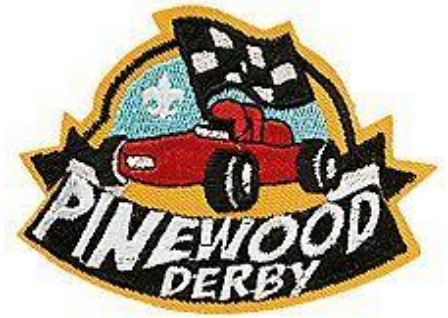

### Registration and Inspection- Friday, January 29

- Weigh-in- Please have only **the Scout and one adult** bring your completed car to The Mechanicsburg Club, 333 Heinz Street, Mech. PA 17055 at the following times for registration and inspection on the **evening of Friday, Jan. 29:**
  - Lion and Tigers: 6:30
  - Wolves and Bears: 7:00
  - Webelos: 7:45
- As we are following social distancing protocol, it is VITAL that you are on time and follow the time schedule. We ask that you do not come in prior to your registration time and leave once your car is impounded.
- **Cars must be in Friday night. If you are not able to bring it Friday night, please make arrangements with Kelly ASAP via email or phone, 717-903-6267.**
- Signs will be posted as to where to enter for the race.
- Once a car has completed inspection, it will be impounded and will remain in the hall.

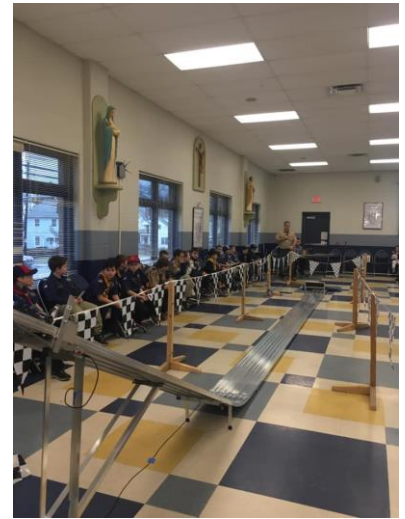

- **Please note-** nothing, including weights, should be hanging from the bottom of your car. It will not pass inspection as it will not be able to go down the track.

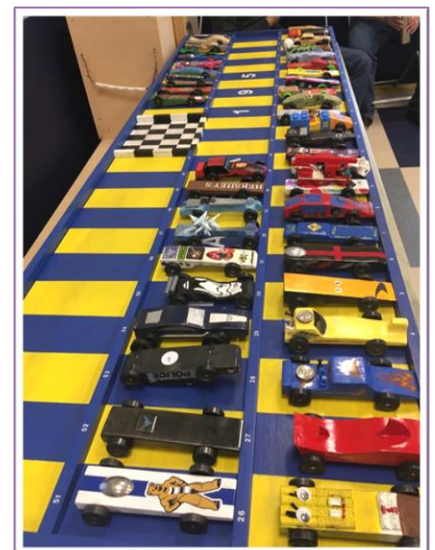
### Race Day- Saturday, January 30

- Each Den has been assigned a time to arrive for their den's race. Please see below for the race day schedule. Only the **Scout and one adult** should be present for the race due to Covid restrictions. All Scouts, leaders, and spectators must be **wearing a mask and follow social distancing.**
- Again, we ask that you please do not enter the facility prior to your den's race time.
- Following your den's race, the den trophies will be presented along with any awards earned by the Scout.
- We will hold a Pack Overall Race around 11:30 for the winners of each den.
- The winners of each den may return for that race or leave the car and it will be raced for them.
- All Scouts should be in class A uniforms. Lions should wear their Lion t-shirts.
- While designing your car, **keep in mind the following awards:** Most Original, Most Patriotic, Most Scout Spirit, Most Colorful, Best Use of Stickers, Best Sports Theme, Best Add-on (Legos, etc.), Best Paint Job, Best Imagination, Most realistic. These will be judged by an independent member of the community.
- For those that are not able to attend in person, we are planning to livestream the event via Facebook Live as well as Zoom. Facebook Live will be via the Pack's private Facebook page. The Zoom link will be sent out before the race via email.

It's hard to believe we are talking about summer camp! As of now, Council is still planning on summer camp at Camp Tuckahoe. Cub Camp (for current Tigers and Wolves) will be from June 20-22, 2021. Webelos camp (for current Bears and Webelos 1) will be from June 27-July 1, 2021.

Scouts: \$315 (if paid before May 1), \$340 (after May 1)

Pack 195 requires a parent to attend with his/her Scout. **All adults must have current clearances and youth protection training prior to camp.**

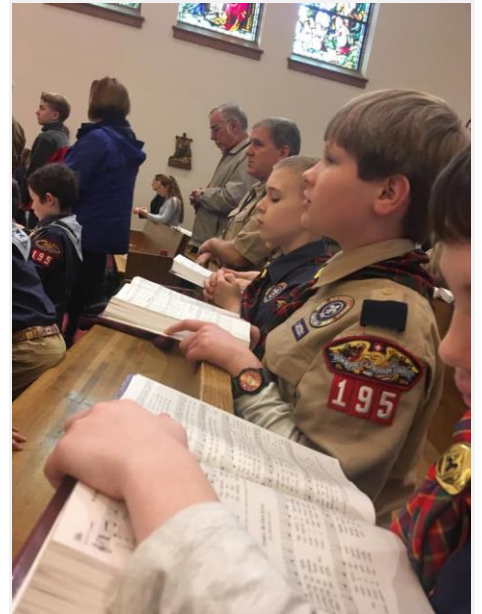

If for any reason camp is canceled, your money will be refunded.

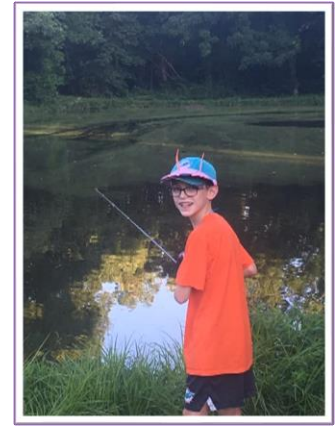
